

**Twenty Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
**September 18th**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

When I celebrate Funeral Masses, I never know who will be in attendance. There are those who are active parishioners, who attend Mass here at St. Joseph and know how we celebrate the Holy Mass. Also, there are those who will attend that are from other parishes that do not have a Communion Rail, and do not know what it is to kneel. There are those who attend who are still very cautious and will wear a mask and still are very awkward in trying to receive Holy Communion. And, there are those who are fallen away Catholics and those who know nothing of the Catholic practices and our worship who will be in attendance. My homily for a funeral is always one that will teach what a funeral Mass is all about and why we do what we do. Also, when I am aware that we have mixed company, I will always give instructions before I distribute Holy Communion – “This part of the Catholic Mass is ‘Holy Communion.’ It is to express our union with the Lord as baptized Catholics and our faith in what Jesus has given us, namely, the bread is now His Body and Blood. All those who are Catholic, and are properly prepared by a good Confession, may come forward to receive Holy Communion.” A recent funeral there were more than I was used to that did not know what to do. When this happens, I actually ask, ‘are you Catholic?’ Some said ‘yes,’ but they did not know how to even receive, and there were some who said, ‘No,’ I am not Catholic. So, of course, I did not give them Holy Communion. Then there were those who still had their masks on and didn’t know how to receive. I actually had to ask them to remove the mask so that they can receive properly. After the Mass, as I was getting ready to leave for the cemetery for the burial, I was approached by a person who wanted to know why I asked her to remove her mask. I told her that so many had desecrated the Eucharist as they tried to force the Eucharist through their mask, others dropped the Host as they tried to hold it and remove their mask at the same time, and still others broke the Host as they tried to lift their mask and put the Host under the mask to receive. She was not happy. She told me that Jesus wouldn’t have cared. Why am I sharing this with you. Well, we have done even more harm to our Catholic faith because of the pandemic. So many no longer understanding the meaning of the Eucharist. The Church has also done harm to herself when it issued a “*dispensation*” from having to attend Mass on Sundays. Still, today, there are many who are more than content with watching Mass on their computer. Yet, we are the Catholic Church, the Church that Jesus has built, and as the Church, we are the Body of Christ – we are what we eat. Over the next few weeks I will be sharing with you what the Eucharistic Revival in the United States is all about.

**Vigésimo Quinto Domingo Del Tiempo**  
**Ordinario Septiembre 18**

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Cuando celebro misas fúnebres, Nunca sé quién estará presente. Hay quienes son feligreses activos, que asisten a misa aquí en San José y saben cómo celebramos la Santa Misa. Además, hay quienes asistirán que son de otras parroquias que no tienen un Riel de Comunión y no saben lo que es arrodillarse. Hay quienes asisten que todavía son muy cautelosos y usarán un cubre boca y todavía están muy incómodos al tratar de recibir la Sagrada Comunión. Y hay aquellos que son católicos caídos y aquellos que no saben nada de las prácticas católicas y de nuestro culto que estarán presentes. Mi homilía para un funeral es siempre una que enseñará de qué se trata una misa fúnebre y por qué hacemos lo que hacemos. Además, cuando soy consciente de que tenemos personas mixtas, Siempre daré instrucciones antes de distribuir la Sagrada Comunión-“Esta parte de la Misa Católica es la ‘Sagrada Comunión’. Es expresar nuestra unión con el Señor como católicos bautizados y nuestra fe en lo que Jesús nos ha dado. es decir, el pan es ahora Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Todos los que son católicos, y están debidamente preparados por una buena Confesión, pueden presentarse para recibir la Sagrada Comunión.” En un funeral reciente allí fueron más de los que estaba acostumbrado que no sabían qué hacer. Cuando esto sucede, de hecho les pregunto, ‘eres Católico?’ algunos dicen que ‘si,’ pero ni siquiera sabían cómo recibir, y hubo algunos que dijeron, ‘No,’ No soy católico. Así que, por supuesto, No les di la Sagrada Comunión. Luego estaban los que todavía tenían sus cubre boca puesto y no sabían cómo recibir. De hecho, tuve que pedirles que se quitaran el cubre boca para que puedan recibirla correctamente. Después de la misa, mientras me preparaba para irme al cementerio para el entierro, Se me acercó una persona que quería saber por qué le pedí que se quitara el cubre bocas. Le dije que muchos habían profanado la Eucaristía mientras trataban de forzar la Eucaristía a través de su cubre bocas, otros dejaron caer la Hostia mientras intentaban sostenerla y quitarse el cubre bocas al mismo tiempo, y otros rompieron la Hostia mientras trataban de levantar su cubre bocas y poner la Hostia debajo de el cubre bocas para recibir. No estaba contenta. Ella me dijo que a Jesús no le habría importado. ¿Por qué estoy compartiendo esto con ustedes? Bueno, hemos hecho aún más daño a nuestra fe católica debido a la pandemia. Muchos ya no entienden el significado de la Eucaristía. La Iglesia también se ha hecho daño a sí misma cuando emitió una “Dispensación” de tener que asistir a misa los domingos. Todavía, hoy, hay muchos que están más que contentos con ver misa en su computadora. Aun, somos la Iglesia Católica, somos el Cuerpo de Cristo-somos lo que comemos. Durante las próximas semanas compartiré con ustedes de qué se trata el Avivamiento Eucarístico en los Estados Unidos.


## **CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER GROUP**



## How to respond to choking, part two

Babies under the age of one are at a risk of choking but handling a blocked airway in such a young child requires a different approach. If the baby cannot cough, cry, or breathe, support him "face down" by holding the head in one hand with the torso on your forearm, against your thigh. Give up to five back thumps between the shoulder blades with the heel of your other hand. If this does not work, roll the infant face up and provide five chest thrusts, about 1 ½ inches deep, with two fingers on the breastbone, just below the nipple line. ### Cómo responder a la asfixia, segunda parte

Los bebés menores de un año corren el riesgo de asfixiarse, pero el manejo de una vía respiratoria bloqueada en un niño tan pequeño requiere abordarlo en una forma distinta. Si el bebé no puede toser, llorar o respirar, sosténgalo "boca abajo" tomando su cabeza con una mano con el torso sobre su antebrazo, contra su muslo. Dé hasta cinco golpes en la espalda entre los omóplatos con la base de la otra mano. Si esto no funciona, ponga al bebé boca arriba y dele cinco compresiones en el pecho, de aproximadamente 1 pulgada y media de profundidad, con dos dedos en el esternón, justo debajo de la línea de los pezones. 


