Third Sunday In Ordinary Time.
January 23rd

Dear Brothers and Sisters,
 We know that Sunday Mass and Adoring the Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist (*Blessed Sacrament*) is of utmost importance to us as Baptized members of the *One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church*.

But why on Sunday?

Saint Pope John Paul II wrote a pastoral letter to all Christians in 1998 entitled: “*Dies Domini*” or “*On Keeping the Lord’s Day Holy*.” The Holy Father taught of the importance of our worship of God at Holy Mass. The first Sabbath day was when God the Father rested on the seventh day. The rest that God took was an active rest. He looked at all He created and said “*It is good*.” He observed His creation in action as He rested. Throughout the Old Testament God reminded His people to “*remember to keep the Sabbath holy*.” This remembering as a way of keeping the Sabbath holy was more than just a passing thought. God called His people to remember that He is the Lord; to remember that He brought them out of slavery; to remember that He gave them the commandments. When the Jewish people gathered on the Sabbath to remember what the Lord did, they actively told the story as if to relive it. For them, to remember was to make the day holy as God continued to create them into His people. The Sabbath is what the Jewish people celebrate from sun-down on Friday to sun-down on Saturday. When the Sabbath is kept holy, they are keeping the third and the first commandments of God.

Why then do we as Catholic Christians celebrate the Sabbath on Sunday? God the Father sent His Son into the world to search out what had been lost by sin; to conquer death. This would be a new creation.

After Jesus nailed sin to the cross and accepted its consequence, death, it was complete. The new creation was accomplished. While in the tomb Jesus descended to the dead and took them to Himself. Then, early Sunday morning He appeared to Mary Magdalene whom he delivered from 7 demons. Then He appeared to the apostles. He observed what He had recreated – the new day of the Lord, Sunday. With all this been said, we can begin to see why the pandemic has harmed the very core of our faith life, our ability to participate what the Lord has accomplished.

Remember to keep holy the Lord’s day.

Tercer Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario.
Enero 23

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,
 Sabemos que la Misa dominical y Adorar al Señor en la Santísima Eucaristía (Santísimo Sacramento) es de suma importancia para nosotros como miembros bautizados de la Iglesia que es Una, Santa, Católica, y Apostólica. Pero porque en domingo?

San Juan Pablo II escribió una carta pastoral a todos los cristianos en 1998 titulada: “*Dies Domini*” o

“*Santificar el día del Señor*.” El Santo Padre enseñó sobre la importancia de nuestra adoración a Dios en la Santa Misa. El primer día de reposo fue cuando Dios Padre descansó en el séptimo día. El descanso que Dios tomó fue un descanso activo. Miró todo lo que creó y dijo “*es bueno*.” Observó Su creación en acción mientras descansaba. A lo largo del Antiguo Testamento, Dios le recordó a su pueblo “*Acuérdate de santificar el sábado*.” Este recuerdo como una forma de santificar el sábado fue más que un pensamiento pasajero. Dios llamó a Su pueblo a recordar que Él es el Señor; a recordar que Él los sacó de la esclavitud; a recordar que Él les dio los mandamientos. Cuando el pueblo judío se reunió en el día de reposo para recordar lo que hizo el Señor, contaron activamente la historia como para revivirla. Para ellos, recordar era santificar el día mientras Dios continuaba creándolos en Su pueblo.

El sábado es lo que el pueblo judío celebra desde la puesta del sol del viernes hasta la puesta del sol del sábado. Cuando el sábado se santifica, están guardando el tercer y el primer mandamiento de Dios. ¿Por qué entonces nosotros, como cristianos católicos, celebramos el sábado el domingo? Dios el Padre envió a Su Hijo al mundo para buscar lo que se había perdido por el pecado; para vencer a la muerte. Esta sería una nueva creación. Después de que Jesús clavó el pecado en la cruz y aceptó sus consecuencias, la muerte, se había cumplido. La nueva creación se llevó a cabo.

Mientras estaba en la tumba, Jesús descendió a los muertos y los llevó a sí mismo. Entonces, La madrugada del domingo se le apareció a María Magdalena, a quien liberó de 7 demonios. Entonces se apareció a los apóstoles.

Teens and social media have been in the news a lot over the past several months, as research shows how damaging social media sites can be for self-esteem, productivity, and overall well-being. Instagram has been called out, with research citing harm done by filters and by bullying in private messages. How can parents protect their children from the negative impacts such a popular and prevalent site cause? Experts recommend keeping open lines of communication with your teenagers, talking to them often about what they see and how they feel about it. Use age and activity limits or monitoring to keep tabs on how your teens are using Instagram and other social media sites.
