Twenty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time
September 4th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,
With the last holiday for the summer, Labor Day, summer is over, and the new school year is already under way. The parish school is now beginning its third week and all Religious Education Classes begin this week. Time seems like it's just flying by. For our Sunday Scripture Readings, we continue with the Gospel of Luke and the theme of discipleship. The message that Jesus gives us helps us to remember what true discipleship is as we get involved in so many activities. When we get busy, we tend to excuse ourselves from keeping up with our spiritual lives. So many make the resolution that they will not get lazy in the spiritual life, but rather keep up with it and even put it as THE PRIORITY. By the time you are reading this article a determination will have already been made if we are moving ahead with the St. Ignatius Spiritual Exercises. If we are moving forward with them, it is because at least 200 hundred people, both parishioners and others from surrounding parishes have made a decision to sacrifice 10 Saturday evenings starting on September 17th, to investing time to deepen their spiritual life by equipping themselves for faithful discipleship. If we are moving ahead with the Spiritual Exercises and you have not yet registered, I challenge you to make that sacrifice, and decide to grow in the spiritual life. It does take effort, and it is work. I bring this up because Jesus challenges us forcefully to follow Him by putting Him first. He says, "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple." Jesus uses some very strong words. Does He really mean we are to hate those closest to us if we are going to follow Him? No. But what He does mean is that if we say, "I am His disciple," but yet, if we prefer father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters and even our own life, over Jesus, then we cannot carry our own cross. Jesus must be first, and to follow Him - carrying our own cross - must be well calculated. This means that everyday we talk to Jesus in prayer, and even several times a day; it means that we have right priorities, never omitting prayer, charitable deeds each day, big and small, Sunday Mass, and monthly confession. If you are a disciple of Jesus, then preferring Jesus to everyone and everything else, everyone and everything will fall into its right place, and indeed, flow from our friendship with Jesus. So, start out the school year putting Jesus first and growing deeper in love with Him. Blessings,

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,
Con las últimas vacaciones para el verano, día del trabajo, el verano termino, y el nuevo año escolar ya está en marcha. La escuela parroquial ahora está comenzando su tercera semana y todas las clases de educación religiosa comienzan esta semana. El tiempo parece que está pasando volando. Para nuestras lecturas dominicales de las Escrituras, continuamos con el Evangelio de Lucas y el tema del discipulado. El mensaje que Jesús nos da nos ayuda a recordar lo que es el verdadero discipulado al involucrarnos en tantas actividades. Cuando estamos ocupados, tendemos a excusarnos de mantenernos al día con nuestras vidas espirituales. Muchos toman la resolución de que no se volverán perezosos en la vida espiritual. sino más bien mantenerse al día e incluso ponerlo como LA PRIORIDAD. Para cuando esté leyendo este artículo, ya se habrá tomado una determinación si estamos avanzando con los Ejercicios Espirituales de San Ignacio. Si estamos avanzando con ellos, es porque al menos 200 personas, tanto los feligreses como otros de las parroquias circundantes han tomado la decisión de sacrificar 10 sábados por la noche a partir del 17 de septiembre. a invertir tiempo para profundizar su vida espiritual equipándose para el discipulado fiel. Si estamos avanzando con los Ejercicios Espirituales y aún no te has registrado, Te reto a que hagas ese sacrificio, y decidas crecer en la vida espiritual. Requiere esfuerzo, y es trabajo. Traigo esto a colación porque Jesús nos desafía enérgicamente a seguirlo poniéndolo a Él primero. Dice, "Si alguien viene a mí sin odiar a su padre y a su madre, esposa e hijos, hermanos y hermanas, y hasta su propia vida, no puede ser mi discípulo. Quien no lleva su propia cruz y viene en pos de mí no puede ser mi discípulo." Jesús usa algunas palabras muy fuertes. ¿Realmente quiere decir que debemos odiar a los más cercanos a nosotros si vamos a seguirlo? No. Pero lo que Sí quiere decir es que si decimos, "Yo soy su discípulo," pero sin embargo, preferimos padre y madre, esposa e hijos, hermanos y hermanas incluso nuestra propia vida, sobre Jesus, entonces no podemos llevar nuestra propia cruz. Jesús debe ser el primero y seguirlo, llevando nuestra propia cruz, debe estar bien calculado. Esto significa que todos los días hablamos con Jesús en oración. e incluso varias veces al día; significa que tenemos prioridades correctas, nunca omitir la oración y obras de caridad cada día, pequeña o grande, Misa Dominical, y confesión mensual. Si eres discípulo de Jesús, entonces prefiriendo a Jesús, que a todos y a todo lo demás, todos y todo caerán en su lugar correcto, y de echo fluye de nuestra amistad con Jesus. Así que, comience el año escolar poniendo a Jesús en primer lugar y profundizando en el amor con Él. Bendiciones,

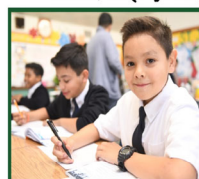

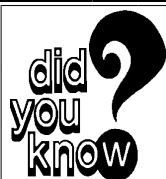
NUEVA GUIA PARA INTENCIONES DE MISA.

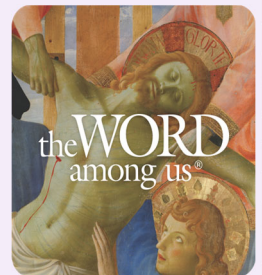
