Fifth Sunday In Ordinary Time.
February 6th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Last week I introduced the topic of Holy Matrimony with the life of Saint Valentine. When a young couple came to Saint Valentine for marriage preparation, they had to be very courageous risking their lives, since it was illegal to enter into Christian Marriage. It was clear that the couple had a sense of God in their life, and they knew that it was at a price. Their marriage would always have a shadow of the cross. Many couples who present themselves for marriage, I am sorry to say, do not have a sense of God in their lives. Their biggest concern when they arrive with me is, can they get the date they want, because they already booked the venue for their reception. I explain to the couple that our first meeting is to see if they actually can enter into the Sacrament of Marriage. They must demonstrate for me that they have a relationship with God and the Church in order for me to have a sure and certain hope that what they are asking to receive will be lived out. To receive the Sacrament of Marriage is to take on a responsibility to witness to the world how the Lord loves us, by the way they love each other. So, the proof is in how they live the Cross. Saint Paul gets right to the point in his letter to the Ephesians chapter 5: *“So be imitators of God, as beloved children, and live in love, as Christ loved us and handed himself over for us as a sacrificial offering to God for a fragrant aroma.”* Wow! That means to surrender yourself completely to the one you love. Paul goes on to say, *“Be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ.”* Then Paul gets specific about the love of a wife for her husband and the love of the husband for his wife. *“Wives should be subordinate to their husbands as to the Lord. For the husband is head of his wife just as Christ is head of the Church... As the Church is subordinate to Christ, so wives should be subordinate to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the Church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, ... that he might present to himself the Church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish.”* The love of husband and wife is to be the very expression of Christ sacrificial love on the cross. Just as Jesus hands his life over for his bride the Church so that she may share completely in his life and become one flesh as He gives himself to us in the Eucharist, so to, does the husband, so that he and his wife may become one flesh. This love relationship is renewed and strengthened every time the couple attends Holy Mass and receives Holy Communion. As Christ gives us himself so that we may be one with him, so does the husband and wife, so that they may be one with each other.

Quinto Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario.
Febrero 6

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

La semana pasada introduje el tema del Santo Matrimonio con la vida de San Valentín. Cuando una joven pareja vino a San Valentín para la preparación del matrimonio, tuvieron que ser muy valientes arriesgando sus vidas, ya que era ilegal entrar en el matrimonio cristiano. Estaba claro que la pareja tenía un sentido de Dios en su vida, y sabían que estaba a un precio. Su matrimonio siempre tendría una sombra de la cruz. Muchas parejas que se presentan para el matrimonio, Lamento decirlo, no tienen un sentido de Dios en sus vidas. Su mayor preocupación cuando llegan conmigo es, si pueden obtener la fecha que desean porque ya reservaron el lugar para su recepción. Le explico a la pareja que nuestra primera reunión es para ver si realmente pueden entrar en el Sacramento del Matrimonio. Deben demostrarme que tienen una relación con Dios y con la Iglesia para que yo tenga una esperanza segura y cierta de que lo que están pidiendo recibir será vivido. Recibir el Sacramento del Matrimonio es asumir la responsabilidad de dar testimonio al mundo de cómo el Señor nos ama. por como, se aman ellos. Así que, la prueba está en cómo viven la Cruz. San Pablo va directo al grano en su carta a los Efesios capítulo 5: *“Así que sed imitadores de Dios, como hijos amados, y vivir en amor, como Cristo nos amó y se entregó a sí mismo por nosotros como una ofrenda sacrificial a Dios por un aroma fragante.”* Wow! Eso significa entregarte completamente a la persona que amas. Pablo continúa diciendo, *“Sean subordinados unos a otros por reverencia a Cristo.”* Luego Pablo se vuelve específico sobre el amor de una esposa por su esposo y el amor del esposo por su esposa. *“Las esposas deben estar subordinadas a sus maridos como al Señor. Porque el esposo es cabeza de su esposa así como Cristo es cabeza de la Iglesia... Como la Iglesia está subordinada a Cristo, así que las esposas deben estar subordinadas a sus maridos en todo. Maridos, amen a sus esposas así como Cristo amó a la Iglesia y se entregó a sí mismo para santificarla,... para que se presente a sí mismo la Iglesia en esplendor, sin mancha o arruga o cualquier cosa por el estilo, para que ella sea santa y sin mancha.”* El amor del esposo y la esposa debe ser la expresión misma del amor sacrificial de Cristo en la cruz. Así como Jesús entrega su vida por su esposa, la Iglesia para que ella pueda participar completamente en su vida y convertirse en una sola carne como Él se entrega a nosotros en la Eucaristía. Así también, el marido, para que él y su esposa se conviertan en una sola carne. Esta relación de amor se renueva y fortalece cada vez que la pareja asiste a la Santa Misa y recibe la Sagrada Comunión. Como Cristo nos da a sí mismo para que seamos uno con él, también lo hace el esposo y la esposa, para que puedan ser uno con el otro.

Child safety has been affected by Covid-19 pandemic

Today, as we deal with the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, it is noteworthy that the *National Center for Missing & Exploited Children* (NCMEC) reported that child safety has also been affected as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. "In 2021, NCMEC stated that they had experienced a 97.5% increase in online enticement reports between January 2020 and December 2020, versus the same time period in 2019." NCMEC maintains a 24-hour hotline at 1-800-843-5678, and the CyberTipline receives reports of child sexual exploitation incidents via an online VIRTUS® article "Online Child Sexual Exploitation and the NCMEC CyberTipline" at lacatholics.org/did-you-know.

"En 2021, el NCMEC declaró que había experimentado un aumento del 97.5 por ciento en los informes de seducción en línea entre enero de 2020 y diciembre de 2020, en comparación con el mismo período de 2019". El NCMEC mantiene una línea directa las 24 horas en el 1-800-843-5678, y CyberTipline recibe informes de incidentes de explotación sexual infantil a través de un formulario en línea en <https://report.cybertip.org/>.
