Fifth Sunday of Easter.
May 15th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This weekend we celebrated two First Holy Communion Masses, 11 students of our Parish School of St. Joseph and 62 children in our Religious Education Classes.

On Sunday, May 22nd, 49 of our teenagers and adults will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. On Sunday, May 29th, 16 children from our Home School Community will receive their First Holy Communion. In the midst of all of this we are celebrating weddings, baptisms and so many confessions. Remember, when we began the Easter Season back on Holy Saturday night, 2 adolescents were fully initiated with Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion, one was welcomed into the Church by making a Profession of Faith and receiving Confirmation and First Holy Communion. And one of the adults received Confirmation. I share this with you to make you aware of the constant growth in our local church of St. Joseph.

This is also happening in every parish throughout the world. What sparked the birth of the Church over 2000 years ago continues to give it new life by adding to her numbers. As I always do the introduction at the start of every year of Faith Formation by teaching parents and the candidates for the Sacraments, "unless Sunday Mass is a weekly part of your faith life, then you render your Baptism meaningless." The first Christians (Catholics were the first Christians) gathered with the community for worship and took their faith with them everywhere. Today we continue with our on-going reading from the Acts of the Apostles. Paul and Barnabas are going from city to city preaching the gospel and establishing the Church. As they did then, so we continue to do today. "The followers of Jesus spent their time learning from the apostles, and they were like family to each other. They also broke bread and prayed together... and each day the Lord added to their group others who were being saved" (Acts 2:42ff). The first charge that I am given as your pastor is to "teach." The primary teaching takes place in preaching at Holy Mass. We are like family together because of our baptism. We are made children of God and members of the Church, thus we are family.

So that the family may be sustained we gather to break bread together, which was the early Church's way of say sharing in the Eucharist. As they gathered together, they said the prayers together in one voice. We say, "In the name of the Father, and ... " We say, "I Confess... , Glory to God in the highest... , Amen, Holy, Holy, Holy, ... ," and so many more. We are very identifiable as the same Church that gathered around the apostles, built by Jesus. Let us pray that the family of believers, the Holy Catholic Church will continue to grow by adding to the number of those who are being saved as we sanctify the world.

Quinto Domingo de Pascua

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Este fin de semana celebramos dos Misas de Primera Comunión, 11 estudiantes de nuestra Escuela Parroquial de San José y 62 niños en nuestras Clases de Educación Religiosa.

El domingo, Mayo 22nd, 49 de nuestros adolescentes y adultos recibirán el Sacramento de la Confirmación. El domingo, Mayo 29, 16 niños de nuestra Comunidad de Escuela en el Hogar recibirán su Primera Comunión. En medio de todo esto estamos celebrando bodas, bautismos y tantas confesiones. Recuerdan, cuando comenzamos la temporada de Pascua en la noche del Sábado de Gloria, 2 adolescentes fueron completamente iniciados con el Bautismo, Confirmación y Primera Comunión, uno fue acogido en la Iglesia haciendo una Profesión de Fe y recibiendo Confirmación y Primera Comunión. Y uno de los adultos recibió la Confirmación. Comparto esto con ustedes para que tomen conciencia del crecimiento constante en nuestra iglesia local de San José. Esto también está sucediendo en todas las parroquias del mundo. Lo que provocó el nacimiento de la Iglesia hace más de 2000 años continúa dándole nueva vida al aumentar sus números. Como siempre hago la introducción al comienzo de cada año de Formación en la Fe enseñando a los padres y a los candidatos a los Sacramentos, "a menos que la misa dominical sea una parte semanal de su vida de fe, entonces haces que tu bautismo carezca de sentido". Los primeros Cristianos (Los católicos fueron los primeros cristianos) se reunieron con la comunidad para adorar y llevaron su fe con ellos a todas partes. Hoy continuamos con nuestra lectura continua de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. Pablo y Bernabé van de ciudad en ciudad predicando el evangelio y estableciendo la Iglesia. Como lo hicieron entonces, así lo seguimos haciendo hoy. "Los seguidores de Jesús pasaron su tiempo aprendiendo de los apóstoles, y eran como una familia el uno para el otro. También partieron el pan y oraron juntos...y cada día el Señor añadía a su grupo a otros que estaban siendo salvos.

(Hechos 2:42ff). El primer cargo que se me da como su pastor es "enseñar" La enseñanza primaria tiene lugar en la predicación en la Santa Misa. Somos como una familia juntos debido a nuestro bautismo. Somos hechos hijos de Dios y miembros de la Iglesia, así somos familia. Para que la familia pueda ser sostenida, nos reunimos para partir el pan juntos, que era la forma en que la Iglesia primitiva decía que participaba en la Eucaristía. Mientras se reunían, dijeron las oraciones juntos en una sola voz. Decimos. "En el nombre del Padre, y..." decimos "Yo Confieso... , Gloria a Dios en las alturas... , Amen, Santo, Santo, Santo... , y muchos más.

Somos muy identificables como la misma Iglesia que se reunió alrededor de los apóstoles. construido por Jesús.

Oremos para que la familia de los creyentes, La Santa Iglesia Católica continúe creciendo al aumentar el número de aquellos que están siendo salvos a medida que santificamos el mundo. Feliz Pascua!
