Solemnity Of The Epiphany Of The Lord
January 8

Merry Christmas Brothers and Sisters!

I pray that the light that has appeared in the heavens has arrived in your hearts and your homes, which is Jesus Christ, the Lord. Today, we celebrate the Epiphany. In many countries, today is the celebration of Christmas and gifts are given. The birth of the Christ Child was announced with the appearance of a star and the Wise Men, that came from afar, followed it until they arrived in Bethlehem. The word “*epiphany*” means that something has been revealed. God has revealed Himself and even gentiles have come to discover what has been revealed, God, made into flesh. This epiphany was for the whole world; that is why it was not to the priests, or the learned, or to the powerful that came to discover this good news. It was the shepherds, the out casts, and even those not of the Jewish people, these Magi, that God announced Himself to. In the time of the early Church, three “*epiphanies*” were celebrated as one – The arrival of the Magi to the manger, the Baptism of the Lord, and the Wedding Feast of Cana. We no longer celebrate them as one, but the arrival of the Magi always has its own Sunday in the Christmas Season. Depending what day of the week Christmas falls on determines whether or not the Baptism of the Lord also has its own Sunday celebration. This year the Baptism of the Lord falls tomorrow, January 9th. Every three years we have the gospel of the Wedding Feast of Cana the Sunday after the Baptism of the Lord, as we did last year. The appearance of the star guided the Magi to the manger in Bethlehem and they came bearing gifts according to how they interpreted the meaning of the star announcing the birth of a new King. They understood, somehow, this baby was God in human flesh. The gifts that they presented gave meaning to what the life of the new born King would be: gold-because He is the King of kings; frankincense-because he would offer sacrifice to the Father as Eternal High Priest; myrrh-because He would be anointed after His sacrifice on the cross. It was the Christ Child that John the Baptist foretold and announced Him when at last He came. As Jesus was baptized in the Jordan River by the Baptist, the voice of God the Father spoke - “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” This event fulfilled the purpose of John the Baptist and revealed the identity of the Christ Child that was born in the manger as the Son of God. At the wedding feast at Cana, Jesus performed His first miracle, changing water to wine. The Gospel of John tells us that “Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed His glory, and His disciples began to believe in Him.” **GLORY TO GOD IN THE HIGHEST, AND ON EARTH PEACE TO PEOPLE OF GOOD WILL.**

Solemnidad De La Epifanía Del Señor
8 de Enero

Feliz Navidad Hermanos y Hermanas, Ruego que la luz que ha aparecido en los cielos haya llegado a sus corazones y a sus hogares. que es Jesucristo, el Señor. Hoy, celebramos la Epifanía. En muchos países, hoy es la celebración de la Navidad y se dan regalos. El nacimiento del Niño Jesús fue anunciado con la aparición de una estrella y los Reyes Magos, que vinieron de lejos, lo siguieron hasta que llegaron a Belén. La palabra “*epifanía*” significa que algo ha sido revelado. Dios se ha revelado a sí mismo e incluso los gentiles han llegado a descubrir lo que ha sido revelado. Dios, hecho carne. Esta epifanía fue para todo el mundo; Por eso no fue a los sacerdotes, o estudiados, o a los poderosos que vinieron a descubrir esta buena noticia. Fueron los pastores, los marginados, e incluso aquellos que no son del pueblo Judío, estos Magos, a los que Dios se anunció. En el tiempo de la Iglesia primitiva, tres “*epifanias*” fueron celebrados como uno solo - La llegada del Magos al pesebre, el Bautismo del Señor, y la Fiesta de Bodas de Cana. Ya no los celebramos como uno solo, pero la llegada de los Reyes Magos siempre tiene su propio domingo en la temporada navideña. Dependiendo de qué día de la semana cae la Navidad determina si el Bautismo del Señor también tiene su propia celebración dominical. Este año el Bautismo del Señor cae mañana, 9 de Enero. Cada tres años tenemos el evangelio de la fiesta de bodas de Cana, el domingo después del Bautismo del Señor, como hicimos el año pasado. La aparición de la estrella guió a los Reyes Magos al pesebre en Belén y vinieron con regalos de acuerdo a cómo interpretaban el significado de la estrella que anunciaba el nacimiento de un nuevo Rey. Ellos entendieron, de alguna manera que, este bebé era Dios en carne humana. Los regalos que presentaron dieron sentido a lo que sería la vida del Rey recién nacido: oro, porque Él es el Rey de reyes; incienso, porque ofrecería sacrificio al Padre como Sumo Sacerdote Eterno; mirra, porque Él sería ungido después de Su sacrificio en la cruz. Fue el Niño Jesús que Juan el Bautista predijo y lo anunció cuando finalmente vino. Como Jesús fue bautizado en el río Jordan por el Bautista, la voz de Dios Padre habló - “Tú eres mi Hijo amado; contigo estoy complacido” Este evento cumplió el propósito de Juan el Bautista y reveló la identidad del Niño Jesús que nació en el pesebre como el Hijo de Dios. En la fiesta de bodas de Caná, Jesús realizó su primer milagro, cambiando el agua a vino. El Evangelio de Juan nos dice que “Jesús hizo esto como el comienzo de sus señales en Caná en Galilea y así reveló su gloria.” **GLORIA A DIOS EN LAS ALTURAS Y EN LA TIERRA PAZ A LOS HOMBRES DE BUENA VOLUNTAD.**

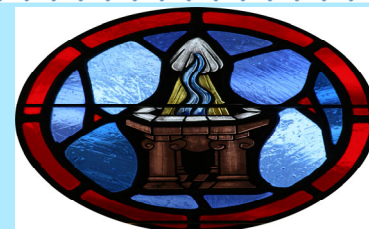


MASS INTENTIONS GUIDELINES.

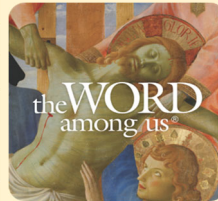

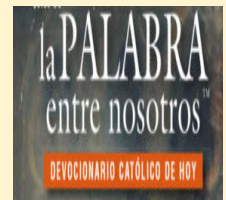
