

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 10th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Two weeks ago, we returned to the Ordinary Cycle of the Scripture readings from the Gospel of Luke. Every year during the summer months we are presented the theme of “Discipleship.” Recall that Jesus has begun His uphill climb to Jerusalem and began to gather his disciples on his journey.

Chapter 9 of the Gospel of Luke begins with Jesus “summoned the Twelve and gave them power over all the demons and to cure diseases, …” Jesus’ fame began to spread with the feeding of the five thousand. Herod and the Jewish leaders began to worry about these activities. Peter confesses that Jesus is “the Messiah of God.” Jesus begins to prepare his disciples of the death that awaits him in Jerusalem and reveals His glory as He transfigures before Peter, James and John. It now becomes very real for the disciples. Jesus lays down the conditions of Discipleship so as to put meaning into the power that he manifests before them – driving out demons of those who were possessed. After Jesus sends out the seventy-two and continues on His journey to Jerusalem, He is asked by a scholar, “What must I do to inherit eternal life?” Jesus turns the question back at the scholar, who then quotes the Scriptures, “You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart… , and your neighbor as yourself.” As the scholar asks the question, “And who is my neighbor?” Jesus teaches the parable of the Good Samaritan. Remember, the Samaritans and the Jews do not like each other, yet it was the Samaritan that helped the man who was left for dead. To the Jews, the Samaritans were not capable of doing good. The scholar was not even capable of saying that it was the Samaritan that was the neighbor to the man left for dead, but rather the neighbor was the one who treated him with mercy. This teaching is very timely for us in the climate that we are living in today. Jesus calls all of us to do the same as the Samaritan did, “to treat each other with mercy.” There is such division and hatred in the public arena, and we must be the unsuspected “good Samaritan” treating the other with mercy.” When we are vilified because we are disciples of Jesus, or when someone who has done harm to us because we are disciples of Jesus, we must do as did the “good Samaritan.”

Decimoquinto Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario Julio 10

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Hace dos semanas, volvimos al Ciclo Ordinario de las lecturas bíblicas del Evangelio de Lucas. Cada año durante los meses de verano se nos presenta el tema de “Discipulado”. Recuerde que Jesús ha comenzado su ascenso cuesta arriba a Jerusalén y comenzó a reunir a sus discípulos en su viaje. El capítulo 9 del Evangelio de Lucas comienza con Jesús “llamó a los Doce y les dio poder sobre todos los demonios y para curar enfermedades…” La fama de Jesús comenzó a extenderse con la alimentación de los cinco mil. Herodes y los líderes judíos comenzaron a preocuparse por estas actividades. Pedro confiesa que Jesús es “el Mesías de Dios”. Jesús comienza a preparar a sus discípulos de la muerte que le espera en Jerusalén y revela su gloria al transfigurarse ante Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Ahora se vuelve muy real para los discípulos. Jesús establece las condiciones del Discipulado para dar sentido al poder que manifiesta ante ellos, expulsando los demonios de los endemoniados. Después de que Jesús envía a los setenta y dos y continúa su viaje a Jerusalén, un erudito le pregunta: “¿Qué debo hacer para heredar la vida eterna?” Jesús le devuelve la pregunta al erudito, quien luego cita las Escrituras: “Amarás al Señor, tu Dios, con todo tu corazón... y a tu prójimo como a ti mismo”. Cuando el erudito hace la pregunta: “¿Y quién es mi prójimo?” Jesús enseña la parábola del buen samaritano. Recuerde, los samaritanos y los judíos no se agradan, pero fue el samaritano quien ayudó al hombre que fue dado por muerto. Para los judíos, los samaritanos no eran capaces de hacer el bien. El erudito ni siquiera fue capaz de decir que era el samaritano el prójimo del hombre dado por muerto, sino que el prójimo era el que lo trataba con misericordia. Esta enseñanza es muy oportuna para nosotros en el clima que vivimos hoy. Jesús nos llama a todos a hacer lo mismo que hizo el samaritano, “tratarnos unos a otros con misericordia”. Hay tal división y odio en la arena pública, y debemos ser el “buen samaritano” insospechado que trata al otro con misericordia”. Cuando somos vilipendiados por ser discípulos de Jesús, o cuando alguien nos ha hecho daño por ser discípulos de Jesús, debemos hacer como el “buen samaritano”.



Check your smoke alarms

The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recommends that smoke alarms be installed on every level of the home, inside every bedroom, and outside every sleeping area. Keep alarms away from drafts caused by fans or air ducts, as this could blow smoke away from the sensor. The NFPA also recommends that you test your alarms at least once a month, and replace the batteries every six months, or as soon as a low battery chirp is heard. Revise sus detectores de humo

La Asociación Nacional de Protección contra Incendios (NFPA, por sus siglas en inglés) recomienda que se instalen detectores de humo en todos los niveles de la casa, dentro de cada dormitorio y fuera de cada área para dormir. Mantenga las alarmas alejadas de corrientes de aire provocadas por ventiladores o conductos de aire, ya que esto podría alejar el humo del sensor. La NFPA también recomienda que pruebe sus alarmas al menos una vez al mes y reemplace las baterías cada seis meses, o tan pronto como escuche un sonido de batería baja. If you still need to receive any of the following sacraments this is the program for you. We have Open Enrollment until Monday, August 8th. Classes are only offered In-person.

Documents needed to accompany RCIA/RICA application forms are as follows:

- Birth certificate only if seeking Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation
- Baptismal certificate only if seeking the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation
- If you need the sacrament of Confirmation only, both Baptismal and Holy Communion certificates are required



Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos

El Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos (RICA) es un programa para adultos (Estudiantes de Secundaria y mayores) que te prepara para el Bautismo, la Primera Comunión y la Confirmación. Si aún necesita recibir alguno de los siguientes sacramentos, este es el programa para usted. Tenemos inscripción abierta hasta el lunes 8 de agosto. Las clases solo se ofrecen en persona.

Los documentos necesarios para acompañar los formularios de solicitud de RCIA / RICA son los siguientes:
