Third Sunday in Ordinary Time
January 22

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we begin the third week of Ordinary Time and return to the Gospel of Saint Matthew. Every year the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time, our return to Ordinary Time after the Christmas Season, we begin with the Gospel of Saint John. As we began this new Liturgical Year on the first Sunday of Advent, Saint Matthew will be our Gospel till November 26th, the Solemnity of Christ, the King of the Universe, with the exception of a few Sundays in Lent and the Easter Season. These weeks of Ordinary Time leading us to Ash Wednesday and the Season of Lent, is to order our lives after the life of Jesus. Last Sunday began with the announcement of John the Baptist, after he baptized Jesus, that Jesus is the “Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.” Today, we hear about the beginning of the public life of Jesus with the calling of His first disciples.

The Jewish world was waiting for the coming of the Messiah. They waited for so long, and when He came, Jesus called Andrew and his brother Simon who is called Peter. Then He called the sons of Zebedee, James and John. Their prayers and fasting was so that they would be ready for the Messiah’s arrival. Now that He has arrived and calls them, they leave everything behind to follow Jesus. For us today, as we strive to pattern our lives after the life of Jesus, have we always been ready to respond to Jesus without resistance? We are all called to follow Jesus in different ways according to our state in life – young or old, male or female, married or single – and that call progresses as we progress in life. We respond in one way when we are young and single, and in another way when we mature and go into the world as a single person or a married person. Then you respond differently when we take on the responsibility of a family. Sometimes, the response is with a radical change of life. This is how we learn to order our life after the life of Jesus. Last Sunday we began our continuous reading from Saint Paul’s first letter to the Corinthians. This letter of Saint Paul will take us to February 19th, the final Sunday before we begin Lent. Saint Paul began with an introduction of himself to the church community that he himself established. After leaving from there he writes from Ephesus to remind them of their calling as those who have been sanctified in Christ Jesus and have been called to be holy. Today he addresses divisions that have risen in the community. As Paul reminded them, he reminds us today, that Jesus is not divided. The Church is the Body of Christ, and He is the head and we are His Body. No matter where we live in the world, no matter who baptized us, and no matter what parish we belong to, we are to be one in our faith. If we are divided we cease being connected to Jesus and His Church. Let us be mindful as we begin this new Liturgical Year to truly pattern our life after the life of Jesus.

Tercer Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario
22 de Enero

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Hoy comenzamos la tercera semana del Tiempo Ordinario y volvemos al Evangelio de San Mateo. Cada año el Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, nuestro regreso al Tiempo Ordinario después de la temporada navideña, comenzamos con el Evangelio de San Juan. Al comenzar este nuevo año litúrgico el primer domingo de Adviento, San Mateo será nuestro Evangelio hasta el 26 de noviembre, la solemnidad de Cristo, Rey del Universo, con la excepción de algunos domingos en Cuaresma y la temporada de Pascua. Estas semanas del Tiempo Ordinario nos llevan al Miércoles de Ceniza y al Tiempo de Cuaresma, es ordenar nuestras vidas según la vida de Jesús. El domingo pasado comenzó con el anuncio de Juan el Bautista, después de bautizar a Jesús, que Jesús es el “Cordero de Dios que quita el pecado del mundo.” Hoy, escuchamos sobre el comienzo de la vida pública de Jesús con el llamado de sus primeros discípulos. El mundo judío estaba esperando la venida del Mesías. Esperaron tanto tiempo, y cuando Él vino, Jesús llamo a Andrés y su hermano Simón que se llama Pedro. Entonces llamó a los hijos de Zebedeo, Santiago y Juan. Sus oraciones y ayuno eran para que estuvieran listos para la llegada del Mesías. Ahora que Él ha llegado y los llama, dejan todo atrás para seguir a Jesús. Para nosotros hoy, mientras nos esforzamos por modelar nuestras vidas según la vida de Jesús, ¿Hemos estado siempre listos para responder a Jesús sin resistencia? Todos estamos llamados a seguir a Jesús de diferentes maneras según nuestro estado de vida - joven o Viejo, hombre o mujer, casados o solteros - y ese llamado progresa a medida que progresamos en la vida. Respondemos de una manera cuando somos jóvenes y solteros, y de otra manera cuando maduramos y vamos al mundo como una persona soltera o una persona casada. Entonces respondes de manera diferente cuando asumimos la responsabilidad de una familia. A veces, La respuesta es con un cambio radical de vida. Así es como aprendemos a ordenar nuestra vida según la vida de Jesús. El domingo pasado comenzamos nuestra lectura continua de la primera carta de San Pablo a los Corintios. Esta carta de San Pablo nos llevará al 19 de febrero, el último domingo antes de comenzar la Cuaresma. San Pablo comenzó con una introducción de sí mismo a la comunidad eclesial que él mismo estableció. Después de salir de allí, escribe desde Éfeso para recordarles su llamado de aquellos que han sido santificados en Cristo Jesús y han sido llamados a ser santos. Hoy aborda las divisiones que han surgido en la comunidad. Como Pablo les record, Él nos recuerda hoy, que Jesús no está dividido. La Iglesia es el Cuerpo de Cristo, y Él es la cabeza y nosotros somos Su Cuerpo. No importa dónde vivamos en el mundo, No importa quién nos haya bautizado, y no importa a qué parroquia pertenezcamos, Debemos ser uno en nuestra fe. Si estamos divididos dejamos de estar conectados con Jesús y Su Iglesia. Seamos conscientes al comenzar este nuevo Año Litúrgico para modelar verdaderamente nuestra vida según la vida de Jesús.

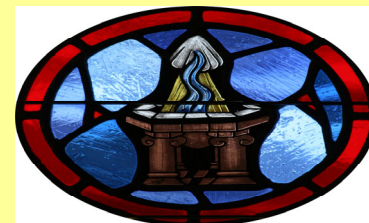
Free Zoom Presentation: **Understanding the Annulment Process (Declaration of Nullity)**

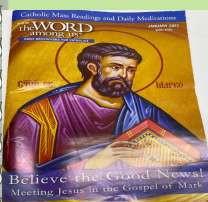
