



Twenty Sunday in Ordinary Time,
August 29th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We have concluded our five-week series from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians and chapter 6 of John's Gospel. This is opportune in real time for us as, a Church and as a nation. As Saint Paul presented to us a teaching on what it means to be Church, the bride of Christ, we must know the reason why we receive the most Holy Eucharist. Both the Church and the Eucharist are inseparable. I say this theme was opportune because we are being challenged in the midst of Covid-19 regulations, protocols, restrictions, mandates, a loss of freedom, etc., and on the ignorance of many, what the Holy Eucharist is, who can receive, how to receive, etc. Also, as we heard last Sunday as we concluded Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, what is the true meaning of Marriage and why it is sacred. The Truth is always the hook to make a catch. The Truth is constant and never changing. The Truth is the instruction for life. All too often we throw out the Truth so that we can live free. But the Truth calls us to make a decision as to our response, as to how we will live. Holy Mother Church, every year, gives us the opportunity to grow in the life of Christ. In God's wisdom, the cycle of Scripture Readings for Sunday and for weekdays, are always applicable to what is going on in the world. God's word has something to say to us in every time and circumstance. So just as Joshua spoke to the Israelites – "decide today whom you will serve, ... As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." And after Jesus' teaching of the Bread of Life, and how many abandoned Him because it was just to hard or fare fetched for them to belief, Jesus asks His apostles – "Do you also want to leave?" When times and circumstances put us to the test we are moved to double down so as to remain faithful to the Truth, or we just abandon ship. As we continue in the final days of summer and look to the beginning of the school year and the hope of returning to some sort of normalcy, today, our Sunday Scripture Readings keep us on track by reminding us what is true. Moses in our reading from Deuteronomy, the Apostle James, and Jesus, all remind us what the Lord has given us so that we can continue our on-going conversions, growing in holiness and perfection in the midst of very challenging times. Holy Mother Church, in her care for us, wants to keep us close to the Lord and His love. I remember so many times hearing my own mom reminding my brothers and sister to do the right thing and how often I heard them respond with resistance because they did not like to be reminded what to do. This was usually because they were already planning to do wrong. Allow God's word to continue to guide and shape you.


Vigésimo Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, 29 de Agosto

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Hemos concluido nuestra serie de cinco semanas de la Carta de Pablo a los Efesios y el capítulo 6 del Evangelio de Juan. Esto es oportuno en el tiempo real para nosotros como Iglesia y como nación. Como san Pablo nos presentó una enseñanza sobre lo que significa ser Iglesia, la esposa de Cristo, debemos saber la razón por la que recibimos al Santísimo Eucaristía. Tanto la Iglesia como la Eucaristía son inseparable. Digo que este tema fue oportuno porque estamos siendo desafiados en medio de Covid-19 reglamentos, protocolos, restricciones, mandatos, pérdida de libertad, etc., y del desconocimiento de muchos, qué es la Sagrada Eucaristía, quién puede recibir, cómo recibir, etc. Carta a los Efesios, ¿cuál es el verdadero significado de El matrimonio y por qué es sagrado. La Verdad es siempre el anzuelo para atrapar. La Verdad es constante y nunca cambia. La Verdad es la instrucción para la vida. Con demasiada frecuencia desecharmos la Verdad para poder vivir libres. Pero la Verdad nos llama a tomar una decisión en cuanto a nuestra respuesta, en cuanto a cómo viviremos. La Santa Madre Iglesia, cada año, nos da la oportunidad de crecer en la vida de Cristo. En la sabiduría de Dios, el ciclo de lecturas bíblicas para Los domingos y los días laborables son siempre aplicables a lo que sucede en el mundo. La palabra de Dios tiene algo que decírnos en todo momento y circunstancia. Así como Josué les habló a los israelitas: "Decidan hoy a quién servirán ... En cuanto a mí y mi casa, serviremos al Señor". Y después de la enseñanza de Jesús sobre el pan de vida, y cuántos lo abandonaron porque era demasiado difícil o caro para ellos creer, Jesús les pregunta a sus apóstoles: "¿También ustedes quieren irse?" Cuando los tiempos y las circunstancias nos ponen a prueba, nos sentimos movidos a redoblarlos para permanecer fieles a la Verdad, o simplemente abandonamos el barco. A medida que continuamos en los últimos días del verano y miramos hacia el comienzo del año escolar y la esperanza de regresar a algún tipo de normalidad, hoy, nuestras Lecturas bíblicas dominicales nos mantienen en el camino correcto recordándonos lo que es verdad. Moisés en nuestra lectura de Deuteronomio, el apóstol Santiago y Jesús, todos nos recuerdan lo que el Señor nos ha dado para que podamos continuar nuestras continuas conversiones, creciendo en santidad y perfección en medio de tiempos muy desafiantes. La Santa Madre Iglesia, en su cuidado por nosotros, quiere mantenernos cerca del Señor y de Su amor. Recuerdo muchas veces haber escuchado a mi propia mamá recordándole a mis hermanos y hermana que hicieran lo correcto y cuántas veces los escuché responder con resistencia porque no les gustaba que les recordaran qué hacer. Por lo general, esto se debía a que ya estaban planeando hacer algo mal. Permita que la palabra de Dios continúe guiándolo y moldeándolo.



Teach children how to answer the door

You would never knowingly let someone dangerous or unsafe into your home. But it is impossible to fully vet every stranger — maintenance worker, new neighbor, salesperson, etc. — who shows up at your door. Teach children a few tips about answering (or not answering) the doorbell. Consider these rules, or something similar, for your family: Always look to see who is at the door first. If the person is a stranger, get an adult to answer the door. Do not open the door to someone you do not know.
