Fifth Sunday Of Lent
March 26

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We have just 10 days left of the 40 days of the Season of Lent. Next Sunday we already begin Holy Week. As I write to you, Tuesday of the 4th Week of Lent, the Church draws our attention to the waters of Baptism and the Easter Sacraments. The Prophet Ezekiel was given a vision by an angel of the Lord – “The angel brought me back to the entrance of the temple of the Lord, and I saw water flowing out from beneath the threshold of the temple... the water flowed down from the right side of the temple, ... the angel had me wade through the water which was ankle-deep... the water was up to my waist...but there was now a river through which I could not wade; for the water had risen so high it had become a river that could not be crossed except by swimming.” With this vision we recall the water that gushed forth from the rock in the desert that gave water to the Israelites for 40 years. Recall, when Jesus offered living water to the Samaritan woman. Jesus is this source of living water. Living Water is water that is flowing, gushing forth with the strength to stir and cause you to tumble. The image that comes to mind is when I was a child I remember family trips to the beach. I recall standing at the shoreline and the waves coming up so forceful, even though I tried to brace myself, I was knocked down and was stirred up. After tumbling a bit I was able to get back up. This is the image that is given to us by the Prophet Ezekiel of this water gushing forth from the temple. Jesus is the very source of this water. Today, this water gushes forth from the Church. I remember when we were ordered to dry out the baptismal font and there is no holy water in the church due to the coronavirus. I look forward to blessings fresh water on Holy Saturday night when the elect will be able to step into the water. Soon, they will be anointed “with the oil of salvation in the name of Christ our Savior.

May He strengthen them with his power.” This will prepare them to not just wade in the waters of Baptism but be able to swim. In other words, to be clothed with Jesus so as to live a new life in Him, being stirred up, so as to become a new creation, a child of God, and a member of the Church. For the rest of us, the Baptized, also have been challenged to swim through the water. We too, have been called to conform our lives to Christ and be faithful to the Gospel. The water is intended, also to stir us up to new life.

On Easter Sunday we will renew our baptismal promises and have the water gush forth upon us as well. The Holy Water is not just a reminder of our baptism, but also, it is a defense against the attacks of the evil one. The devil flees away from the Holy Water as it stirs us up to resist temptations and to be faithful to Christ, who is our clothing, our white garment, our Christian dignity. The Holy Water is a necessary, constant sacramental for a life of holiness, especially for this time in the desert.

Come to the waters of re-birth.

Quinto Domingo De Cuaresma
26 de Marzo

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Nos quedan solo 10 días de los 40 días del Tiempo de Cuaresma. El próximo domingo ya comenzamos la Semana Santa. Mientras te escribo, Martes de la 4^a Semana de Cuaresma, la Iglesia llama nuestra atención sobre las aguas del Bautismo y los Sacramentos Pascuales. El profeta Ezequiel recibió una visión de un ángel del Señor- “El ángel me trajo de vuelta a la entrada del templo del Señor y vi agua que salía de debajo del umbral del temploEl agua fluía desde el lado derecho del templo,... El ángel me hizo vadear el agua que me llegaba hasta los tobillos...El agua me llegaba hasta la cintura...pero ahora había un río a través del cual no podía vadear; porque el agua había subido tanto que se había convertido en un río que no se podía cruzar excepto nadando.” Con esta visión recordamos el agua que brotó de la roca en el desierto que dio agua a los israelitas durante 40 años. Recuerda, cuando Jesús ofreció agua viva a la mujer samaritana. Jesús es esta fuente de agua viva. El Agua Viva es agua que fluye, brotando con la fuerza para agitarse y hacer que te caigas. La imagen que me viene a la mente es que cuando era niño recuerdo viajes familiares a la playa. Recuerdo estar parado en la orilla y las olas que subían con tanta fuerza, a pesar de que traté de prepararme, fui derribado y rebolcado. Después de caer un poco pude volver a levantarme. Esta es la imagen que nos da el profeta Ezequiel de esta agua que brota del templo. Jesús es la fuente misma de esta agua. Hoy, esta agua brota de la Iglesia. Recuerdo cuando nos ordenaron secar la pila bautismal y no había agua bendita en la iglesia debido al coronavirus. Espero con ansias las bendiciones del agua fresca en la noche del Sábado de Gloria cuando los elegidos puedan entrar en el agua.

Pronto, serán ungidos “con el óleo de la salvación en el nombre de Cristo nuestro Salvador. Que Él los fortalezca con su poder.” Esto los preparará no solo para vadear en las aguas del Bautismo, sino para poder nadar. En otras palabras, vestirse de Jesús para vivir una nueva vida en Él, siendo movidos, para convertirse en una nueva creación, un hijo de Dios y miembro de la Iglesia. Para el resto de nosotros, los Bautizados, También hemos sido desafíados a nadar a través del agua. tambien nosotros, hemos sido llamados a conformar nuestras vidas a Cristo y a ser fieles al Evangelio. El agua está destinada también, para incitarnos a una nueva vida. El domingo de Pascua renovaremos nuestras promesas bautismales y haremos que el agua brote sobre nosotros también. El Agua Bendita no es sólo un recordatorio de nuestro bautismo, sino tambien, Es una defensa contra los ataques del maligno. El diablo huye del Agua Bendita mientras nos incita a resistir las tentaciones y a ser fieles a Cristo, Quién es nuestro vestido, nuestra vestidura blanca, nuestra dignidad cristiana. El Agua Bendita un necesario, constante sacramental para una vida de santidad, especialmente para este tiempo en el desierto.

Ven a las aguas del renacimiento.
