

**Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**  
**January 29**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Since the Feast of the Epiphany the Scriptures have focused us on the Light, which is Christ. God has manifested Himself to us. Today we begin Matthew chapter 5, the great Sermon on the Mount, the most famous sermon of Jesus and very important in the life of the Church. Chapter 5 of Matthew will take us to Sunday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, the last Sunday before Ash Wednesday.

The Sermon on the Mount actually goes from chapter 5 to chapter 7. We will move slowly through this Sermon for the next 4 Sundays because these teachings are so important in the life of a disciple and the very life of the Church. One of my favorite saints is Saint Augustine, Bishop of Hippo in Africa, son of Saint Monica, who lived in the fourth century. In a commentary he wrote on the Sermon on the Mount, he said, "If anyone were to ponder with piety and seriousness the sermon which our Lord Jesus Christ gave on the mount, I believe that he would discover there, as far as norms for high moral living are concerned, the perfect way to lead the Christian life." Saint Augustine sees the Sermon on the Mount as the guide to living a Christian life, as the guide to Christian morality. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that the Law of the Gospel is expressed particularly in the Sermon on the Mount. This particular year, with the Gospel of Saint Matthew as our guide, we are given these weeks as a good preparation for the season of Lent. If we have seen the great light that has been shown to "a people who sit in darkness" or who are in its shadow, then this sermon of Jesus is the flesh of the light that Jesus is.

By embracing this teaching of Jesus we can shine brightly to the world the light that we have seen. This sermon begins with the Beatitudes. Each Beatitudes has two parts: first - a virtue of a faithful disciple and; second – what is the blessing of the disciple who perseveres in that virtue even when the world is against you. The disciple who is filled with joy, because they are loved by God, is happy to endure any type of hardship for the sake of His name. This is the test of true discipleship, if you can just persevere without vengeful feelings or reactions as a disciple of Jesus, you will merit God's reward. The Beatitudes are known as the Commandments of the New Testament. God gave the Israelites the 10 Commandments so that His people would know how to have a right relationship with Him and a right relationship with their neighbor. Jesus on the mountain gives this new law so that his followers would know how to live a right relationship with Him and their neighbor. I encourage you to read chapter 5-7 for your own meditation.

**Cuarto Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario**  
**29 de Enero**

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos,

Desde la Fiesta de la Epifanía, las Escrituras nos han enfocado en la Luz, que es Cristo. Dios se ha manifestado a nosotros. Hoy comenzamos Mateo capítulo 5, el gran Sermón de la Montaña, el sermón más famoso de Jesús y muy importante en la vida de la Iglesia. El capítulo 5 de Mateo nos llevará al domingo, 19 de Febrero, el último domingo antes del Miércoles de Ceniza. El Sermón del Monte en realidad va del capítulo 5 al capítulo 7. Nos moveremos lentamente a través de este Sermón durante los próximos 4 domingos porque estas enseñanzas son muy importantes en la vida de un discípulo y en la vida misma de la Iglesia. Uno de mis santos favoritos es San Agustín, Obispo de Hipona en África, hijo de Santa Mónica, que vivieron en el siglo IV. En un comentario escribió sobre el Sermón del Monte, y dijo, "Si alguien reflexionara con piedad y seriedad sobre el sermón que nuestro Señor Jesucristo dio en el monte, Creo que él descubriría allí, En lo que respecta a las normas para una vida moral elevada, la manera perfecta de llevar la vida cristiana." San Agustín ve el Sermón de la Montaña como la guía para vivir una vida Cristiana, como guía de la moral cristiana. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica dice que la Ley del Evangelio se expresa particularmente en el Sermón de la Montaña. Este año en particular, con el Evangelio de San Mateo como guía, se nos dan estas semanas como una buena preparación para el tiempo de Cuaresma. Si hemos visto la gran luz que se ha mostrado a, "Un pueblo que se sienta en la oscuridad" o que están a su sombra, entonces este sermón de Jesús es la carne de la luz que Jesús es. Al abrazar esta enseñanza de Jesús, podemos hacer brillar al mundo la luz que hemos visto. Este sermón comienza con las Bienaventuranzas. Cada Bienaventuranza tiene dos partes: primero - una virtud de un discípulo fiel y; segundo - ¿Cuál es la bendición del discípulo que persevera en esa virtud incluso cuando el mundo está en tu contra? El discípulo que está lleno de gozo, porque son amados por Dios, está feliz de soportar cualquier tipo de dificultad por el bien de Su nombre. Esta es la prueba del verdadero discipulado, si puedes perseverar sin sentimientos o reacciones vengativas como discípulo de Jesús, merecerás la recompensa de Dios. Las Bienaventuranzas son conocidas como los Mandamientos del Nuevo Testamento. Dios les dio a los israelitas los 10 mandamientos para que su pueblo supiera cómo tener una relación correcta con Él y una relación correcta con su prójimo. Jesús en la montaña da esta nueva ley para que sus seguidores sepan cómo vivir una relación correcta con Él y su prójimo. Te animo a leer el capítulo 5-7 para tu propia meditación.
