

Palm Sunday Of Lent  
April 2

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we begin Holy Week, the most solemn week of the Church year. Today we commemorate the triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem. In ancient and biblical times palm branches were a sign of victory. In ancient Olympic games a crown of palm leaves were awarded to the victors. When a king triumphantly entered into his city, palm branches were waved at him. The crowds so hopefully wanted a king to deliver them from the Roman yoke and they were hoping that Jesus would be the one to finally conquer the Romans. Many Catholics have the custom of placing the blessed palm branches in their home or even in their car. Do these palm branches that we so proudly display hail Jesus as king by the way we live our daily lives? Recall that the same people who hailed Jesus as their king by waving palm branches at him, just a few days later were so easily convinced to yell out “crucify him.” Are we easily convinced to do the same? What a great reminder and spiritual help for us throughout the year. Perhaps you still have last year’s palm branch in your prayer space at home or at work to help you always remember to hail Jesus as your King. Tomorrow, Monday of Holy Week, Archbishop Gomez will celebrate the annual Chrism Mass in our mother church, the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels. It will be livestreamed on [facebook.com/lacatholics](https://facebook.com/lacatholics).

Fr. Everardo and I will be in attendance, as well as many other parishioners. You are welcome to attend if you are so inclined. The Mass starts at 7pm. Traditionally, during this Mass, the priests renew their vows with the Archbishop, the people gathered are asked to pray for the clergy. Also, the Archbishop will bless the three oils that will be used in the celebration of the sacraments throughout the year. The Oil of Chrism – used in Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders. The Oil of Catechumen – used in Baptism. The Oil of the Sick – used in the Sacrament of the Sick. As the priests renew their vows with the Archbishop, and as he is the one who blesses the Oils, the ministry of the Archbishop, as the chief shepherd of the local Church of Los Angeles, is present in the Sacramental Life of the Church. Following the Chrism Mass these Oils will be brought to Saint Joseph for use throughout the year. The Triduum, the celebration of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, is the commemoration of the Lord’s Passover. Our salvation is accomplished and the new creation is completed and the gates of Heaven are opened once again. These three days are celebrated as one. We begin with the Mass of Holy Thursday which is the commemoration of the Last Supper and the Commandment of Love; We continue on Good Friday, to fulfill what was done with bread and wine and words on Holy Thursday, to commemorate the death of the Lord on the Cross; We continue on Holy Saturday evening to celebrate what the death of the Lord accomplished through His resurrection and we end with the blessing and are sent forth. These are truly holy and beautiful celebrations, filled with much life. Let us now enter into the celebration.

Domingo De Ramos  
2 de Abril

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Hoy, Comenzamos la Semana Santa, la semana más solemne del año eclesiástico. Hoy conmemoramos la entrada triunfal de Jesús en Jerusalén. En la antigüedad y en los tiempos bíblicos, las ramas de palma eran un signo de victoria. En los antiguos juegos olímpicos se otorgaba una corona de hojas de palma a los vencedores. Cuando un rey entró triunfalmente en su ciudad, Las ramas de palma se agitaron hacia él. Las multitudes tan esperanzadas querían un rey que los liberara del yugo romano y esperaban que Jesús fuera el que finalmente conquistara a los romanos. Muchos católicos tienen la costumbre de colocar las ramas de palma benditas en su casa o incluso en su automóvil. ¿Estas ramas de palma que tan orgullosamente mostramos saludan a Jesús como rey por la forma en que vivimos nuestra vida diaria? Recuerde que las mismas personas que aclamaron a Jesús como su rey agitando ramas de palma hacia él, solo unos días después fueron tan fáciles de convencer de gritar, “cricificalo” ¿Nos convencemos fácilmente de hacer lo mismo? Qué gran recordatorio y ayuda espiritual para nosotros durante todo el año. Tal vez todavía tienes la rama de palma del año pasado en tu espacio de oración en casa o en el trabajo para ayudarte a recordar siempre aclamar a Jesús como tu Rey. Mañana, Lunes de Semana Santa, El Arzobispo Gómez celebrará la Misa Crismal anual en nuestra iglesia madre, la Catedral de Nuestra Señora de los Ángeles. Será transmitido en vivo en [facebook.com/lacatholics](https://facebook.com/lacatholics). El P. Everardo y yo estaremos presentes, así como muchos otros feligreses. Le invitamos a asistir si así lo desea. La misa comienza a las 7pm. Tradicionalmente, durante esta Misa, los sacerdotes renuevan sus votos con el arzobispo, A las personas reunidas se les pide que oren por el clero. Además, el Arzobispo bendecirá los tres aceites que se utilizarán en la celebración de los sacramentos durante todo el año. El aceite del crisma-usado en Bautizos, Confirmacion, y Orden Sacerdotal. El aceite del Catecúmeno-usado en el Bautismo. El Aceite de los Enfermos-usado en el Sacramento de los Enfermos. Mientras los sacerdotes renuevan sus votos con el Arzobispo, y como él es el que bendice los Oleos, el ministerio del Arzobispo, como pastor principal de la Iglesia local de Los Ángeles, está presente en la vida sacramental de la Iglesia. Después de la Misa Crismal, estos aceites serán llevados a San José para su uso durante todo el año. El Triduo, la celebración del Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo, y Sabado de Gloria, es la conmemoración de la Pascua del Señor. Nuestra salvación se ha cumplido y la nueva creación se completa y las puertas del Cielo se abren una vez más. Estos tres días se celebran como uno solo. Comenzamos con la Misa del Jueves Santo, que es la conmemoración de la Última Cena y el mandamiento del Amor, Seguimos el Viernes Santo, para cumplir lo que se hizo con pan, vino y palabras el Jueves Santo, para conmemorar la muerte del Señor en la Cruz; Continuamos el Sábado de Gloria por la noche para celebrar lo que la muerte del Señor logró a través de Su resurrección y terminamos con la bendición y somos enviados. Estas son celebraciones verdaderamente santas y hermosas, llenas de mucha vida.

Entremos ahora en la celebración.






