Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 25th

Dear Brothers and Sisters,
I began last week with the topic of “*ecclesiology*,” the study of the Church. The Church is the “Bride of Christ” and is “Mother” to us. The Church is the “Body of Christ.” Christ has taken on our human flesh so that He could unite our fallen humanity to His Divinity so that we could be restored to our original dignity. By Jesus making us His bride, bathing us in a bath of new birth, the Father will see and love in us what He sees and loves in His Son. Then what Jesus endows His Church with, as revealed in the Holy Scriptures, the Church, as Mother, gives birth to us and gathers us together. The womb of the Church is the baptismal font and the shepherds designated by the Lord, dispense the grace through her sacramental life. This sets the table for us to be fed as God’s children in the Holy Eucharist. Last Sunday, as we concluded Mark’s Gospel, Jesus sees the crowd of people following Him as “sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.” This sets the stage for the “Bread of Life” discourse that we begin today from John’s Gospel chapter 6. What makes us the Body of Christ is the very food that Jesus is for us in the Most Holy Eucharist. Jesus shepherds us with His teachings. We are given what we need to be made ready to receive the reality of God’s Word, His very Flesh and Blood. When our faith leads us to a full embracing of what our Mother teaches us, made into the Bride of Christ, then we become what we eat, the Body of Christ. Because the Eucharist that makes us Church in the truest sense of the word, that is to say, the Body of Christ, not only because we receive the Body of Christ as food, but because Christ has left us His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity and He resides in the Tabernacle. What we begin today in the sixth chapter of John’s Gospel sets the table for the Last Supper and His death on Calvary. John’s Gospel does not have the “Institution Narrative,” that is the last supper account with the bread and wine. John gives us the scene of the washing of the feet. We get the “Institution Narrative” from the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke. What John gives us, which will be the Gospel that will take us to August 22nd, gives us preparation and understanding of the Last Supper and Calvary, and thus teaches what the Eucharistic celebration is for us. When Jesus told Peter – “Upon you I will build my Church, and the gates of hell will not prevail against it” – what force, what power could defeat the power of hell, but Jesus Christ, whose Body and Blood we share and possess, which makes us, the Body of Christ – The Church.
Saint Joseph, protector of the Church – Pray for us.

Decimoseptimo Domingo Del Tiempo Ordinario 25 de Julio

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,
Comencé la semana pasada con el tema de “*ecclesiology*” el estudio de la Iglesia. La Iglesia es la “Esposa de Cristo” y es nuestra “Madre” La Iglesia es el “Cuerpo de Cristo.” Cristo ha tomado nuestra carne humana para que Él pudiera unir a nuestra humanidad caída a Su Divinidad para que pudiéramos ser restaurados a nuestra dignidad original. Por Jesús haciéndonos Su esposa, bañándonos en un baño de nuevo nacimiento, el Padre verá y amará en nosotros lo que ve y ama en Su Hijo. Entonces lo que Jesús dota a su Iglesia como se revela en las Sagradas Escrituras, la Iglesia, como Madre, nos da nacimiento y nos reúne. El vientre de la Iglesia es la pila bautismal y los pastores designados por el Señor, dispensar la gracia a través de su vida sacramental. Esto establece la mesa para que seamos alimentados como hijos de Dios en la Santa Eucaristía. El domingo pasado, como concluimos el Evangelio de Marcos, Jesús ve a la multitud de personas que lo siguen como “ovejas sin pastor; y empezó a enseñarles muchas cosas.” Esto prepara el escenario para el “Pan de Vida.” discurso que comenzamos hoy desde el Evangelio de Juan capítulo 6. Lo que nos hace el Cuerpo de Cristo es el mismo alimento que Jesús es para nosotros en la Santísima Eucaristía. Jesús nos pastorea con Sus enseñanzas. Se nos da lo que necesitamos para estar listos para recibir la realidad de la Palabra de Dios, Su misma Carne y Sangre. Cuando nuestra fe nos lleva a una plena aceptación de lo que nuestra Madre nos enseña, convertido en la esposa de Cristo, no sólo porque recibimos el Cuerpo de Cristo como alimento, sino porque Cristo nos ha dejado Su Cuerpo y Su Sangre, Alma y Divinidad y Él reside en el Tabernáculo. Lo que comenzamos hoy en el sexto capítulo del Evangelio de Juan prepara la mesa para la Última Cena y Su muerte en el Calvario. El Evangelio de Juan no tiene “Narrativa Institucional” esa es la última cena con el pan y el vino. Juan nos da la escena del lavado de los pies. Obtenemos la “Narrativa Institucional” de los Evangelios de Mateo, Marcos, y Lucas. Lo que Juan nos da, que será el Evangelio que nos llevará al 22 de Agosto, nos da preparación y comprensión de la Última Cena y el Calvario, y así enseña lo que la celebración eucarística es para nosotros. Cuando Jesús le dijo a Pedro- “Sobre ti edificaré mi Iglesia, y las puertas del infierno no prevalecerán contra ella” - que fuerza, qué poder podría derrotar el poder del infierno, sino Jesucristo, cuyo Cuerpo y Sangre compartimos y poseemos, lo cual nos hace el cuerpo de Cristo - La Iglesia.

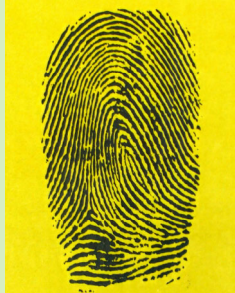

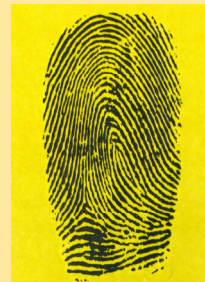
